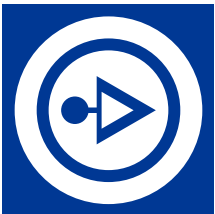

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor if you feel unwell. Rinse mouth.

PRODUCT INFORMATION

VOYAGER 90/10 is an excellent quality, nonionic surfactant. VOYAGER 90/10 can be used with most insecticides, fungicides, herbicides, acaricides, defoliants, desiccants and wettable powders to improve performance of the active spray ingredient by giving them more uniform distribution and better wetting of the plant surface. VOYAGER 90/10 meets the requirements of most pesticide manufacturer's for a 90/10 surfactant. NOT FOR AQUATIC USE.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

REFER TO PESTICIDE LABEL FOR SPECIFIC CROP USE AND APPLICATION RATES. Prior to use, read and follow all directions on this label and on the label of the pesticide being used. Refer to the suggested use rates chart as a guide on usage rates.

MIXING

Follow the instructions on the pest control product label. If there are no specific instructions, add VOYAGER 90/10 after the pest control product has been thoroughly mixed into the tank mix water and preferably after all products have been mixed into the tank.

Suggested Use Rates of Voyager 90/10

APPLICATIONS	PER 100 GALLONS OF MIX
Herbicides	1-4 pints
Insecticides Fungicides Acaricides	1-2 pints
Defoliants Desiccants Wettable Powders	1-2 pints

Variations in conditions of use can cause some variation in the amount of this product required. The minimum required to give a smooth, uniform coverage usually gives the most effective results.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL INFORMATION

STORAGE: Store product locked up in original container away from pesticides, fertilizers, and food or feed, and keep container tightly closed when not in use. Do not use, spill, or store near heat or open flames. Take care to prevent water from being introduced to the contents of this container. Shake well before use. PROTECT FROM FREEZING.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best option of container disposal.
