## APPLICATION INFORMATION - CORN

- Best results are achieved when mite populations are just beginning to build, before the mites have damaged the plants, and the corn is still small enough to allow good coverage.
- Apply high rate to areas with high mite infestation and to areas which historically have had high mite infestations.
- At least 48 fl. oz. per acre should be used under conditions of severe mite pressure.
- **Ground Applications:** Apply in a minimum of 20 gallons total volume per acre.
- **Aerial Applications:** Apply in a minimum of 2 gallons total volume per acre, except in California, Idaho, Oregon and Washington use a minimum of 10 gallons.
- **Chemigation Application (Not in CA):** Apply in 0.1 - 0.2 acre inches of water. (See CHEMIGATION PRECAUTIONS FOR CORN)
- **PHI:** 30 Days - Grain or Silage
